# On simple polyhedrons and associated triangulations

It is shown that every finite point set in Euclidean space, not contained in an affine hyperplane of this space, determines a simple polyhedron of special type (the so-called primitive polyhedron). A certain algorithm for constructing such a polyhedron is described and its complexity is evaluated. Some related questions concerning the combinatorial structure of primitive polyhedrons are also considered.
